As you well know, Judy is our superbly qualified missionary who serves in China on behalf of American Baptist Churches.

We are a group of people here in Wisconsin who have discovered our common enthusiasm for the work which Judy is doing through the Amity Foundation in China. We represent congregations in Wyocena, Beloit, Eau Claire, and Madison. With the helpful guidance of the Board of International ministries, we have formed a Missionary Partnership Team. That means that we want to serve as partners with Judy Sutterlin, providing warm friendship, caring concern, pastoral assistance, and financial support for her many-faceted ministry to Chinese people and to Amity teachers and staff.

Judy has been in this country on Home Assignment for the past year. We thought you might like to know something of the scope of her work during these months, as she has shared so thoroughly and thoughtfully the vast outreach of her ministries in China. Judy traveled to 13 states and around 120 churches and groups reminding us through stories and slides that she not only teaches English to secondary school teachers, but also helps with aids orphans and oversees ABC's support of village clinics.

Judy celebrated Amity Foundations 20th Anniversary in November in China with several partners from the states, visiting several of Amity projects and learning about their goals for the future. In May she represented ABC IM at the China Christian Council Bible Exhibition in Atlanta

Judy has also appreciated having time to be with her family. When not on the road she has lived close to her parents and brother in California and been available to help make living arrangements for her parents to support their changing needs. She enjoyed a two week vacation in Germany with her Pennsylvania brother and sister-in-law searching for family history.

On June 13 Judy will fly to Hong Kong and will return to her usual base in Nanjing on June 24th.
